Sample Fungicide Spray Schedule for Commercial Bramble

Growth Stage	Target Pathogen	Fungicide
Dormant	A	Sulforix
Silver Tip	A, CB, R, SB	Captan
Full Bloom	CB, DB, R, SB	Cabrio, Abound, or Pristine
First Cover~ (14 days after petal fall)	CB, R, SB	Rally
Second Cover~ (14 days later)	CB, R, SB	Cabrio, Abound, or Pristine

Diseases/Target Pathogens

A – Anthracnose, CB – Cane blight, DB – Double blossom, R – Rust, SB – Spur blight

Notes

A preventative fungicide program helps protect plants from infection. This is particularly important during periods of extended rain.

~Phosphorus acid should be added to a fungicide program if soil remains wet or if root rot has been a problem. These fungicides are applied at full leaf expansion and approximately one month later.
